**Registration for the 2012 SUS Grantsmanship Program is now FULL.**

The SUS has launched this program to help junior faculty earn their first grant or make the transition from K to R level funding. The program will consist of a small group session on Wednesday, February 15, from 6:30-7:30 AM during the 7<sup>th</sup> Academic Surgical Congress in Las Vegas, NV.

Registration is now CLOSED and will close on January 2, 2012, **or** when all slots (40) are filled. Please note that you will need to register first for the 2012 ASC meeting prior to registering for the program. You will need your Reference ID from your ASC Meeting Registration to verify you are registered. The Reference ID can be found on your confirmation email.

There will be no additional charge to participate. Attendance will be limited to the first 40 individuals who complete the Grantsmanship Program online registration. In order to complete the registration, you must complete the online form AND include an upload of a copy of the grant you want mentoring on. The grant can be anything from an early detailed outline to a previously submitted, but unfunded, grant. The grant should be in the format of a Word.doc or PDF document. Do not upload any other formats, including .docx formats. A waiting list of 20 people will be maintained in case some individuals drop out.
