Clinical issues: Injuries and sequelae from unsafe abortion attempts that may be encountered by the practicing surgeon. History pre-Roe, current abortion numbers, predictions for the future, impact of medical abortifacients and possible complications, differential impact on rural or deployed surgeons. International experience with restrictive abortion laws and the impact on women's health will also be addressed.

Ethical issues: Pregnant patients may have other pathology; treatment such as chemotherapy, surgery, radiation therapy, or immunotherapy could impact a fetus. How to navigate those discussions with patients in states with restrictive laws. What are the legal implications for a practicing surgeon (Optimal patient care vs. fetal effects)?

Professional issues: What should be the role of an academic surgeon with respect to advocacy in this area? Should we be silent because of our professional identity or impact on our institution? Or do we have a moral obligation to advocate and use our voice as educated professionals? Pro/con debate touching on social media, professional identity, patient choice, responsibility of surgical societies.
