

Guidelines for submitting your AAS Manuscript

Be sure to select '**VSI: ASC 2026**' as the article type and include reference to the ASC 2026 meeting in the cover letter and just before the references.

Title page:

Include the title, a list of authors, their affiliations and complete contact information for the corresponding author. Be sure to include the degrees of each author as well.

Abstract:

- All abstracts should be structured with the following section headings: Introduction, Methods, Results, Conclusions.
- All original articles should have keywords. Keywords should appear immediately after the abstract.
- Body of text- saved in WORD
- Tables- should be included in a separate WORD file
- Figures with legends. Rule of thumb for figures- if you can't draw it, include it in a TIFF or JPG file.

Sections at the End of the Article

Place the following sections at the end of the article, after the Conclusions and before the References.

- Study Type - If applicable
- Level of Evidence - If applicable
- Supplementary Materials - Include information about supplementary materials as well as appropriate links to the materials.
- Author Contributions-A brief paragraph explaining how each author contributed to the submission. All papers should have this section and the information.
- Acknowledgements
 - Disclosure- All papers should have this section and the information.
 - Funding- All papers should have this section and the information.
- Availability of Data- If applicable
- Meeting Presentation - Include information about meeting presentation here rather than as a footnote on the title page.
- Appendix or Appendices - If applicable
